## Frequently asked questions

**Q: Why should people get vaccinated against the flu?**

**A:** Influenza is a potentially serious disease that can lead to hospitalization and sometimes even death. An annual flu vaccine is the best way to help protect against the flu.



**A flu shot cannot cause the flu.**

**Q: Who should get vaccinated this flu season?**

**A:** Everyone 6 months of age and older should get a flu vaccine every year.



Anyone can get the flu and everyone should get a flu shot to **protect themselves and those around them.**

**Q: What protection does the flu shot provide if I do get sick with flu?**

**A:** Some people who get vaccinated may still get sick. However, flu vaccination has been shown in some studies to reduce severity of illness in people who get vaccinated but still get sick.



CDC recommends that people get a flu vaccine **by the end of October**, but getting vaccinated later can still be beneficial.



**The flu shot can take up to 2 weeks to become effective**, so getting it as early as possible is recommended.
